- **Gimhae Gaya Theme Park** - Is a resting area that provides comfortable relaxation in the daily lives of the busy people and a cultural complex where you can experience various cultures with your family, lover and friends.

- **Painters Hero Gaya Kingdom** - This art performance brings a new concept of dance and mime, depicting the process and creation of an art piece. The group behind the performance, The Painters, gained recognition as a semifinalist in Asia's Got Talent.

- **Gamcheon Cultural Village** - Is formed by houses built in staircase-fashion on the foothills of a coastal mountain, earning this village the nickname "Machu Picchu of Busan." Many alleys that cut through this community are vibrantly decorated with murals and sculptures created by the residents.

- **BIFF Square** - Having been remade into a cultural tourist attraction promoting the advancement of Korea's film industry, BIFF Square has contributed to Busan's newfound status as an international cultural tourist city.

- **Jagalchi Market** - Is Korea's largest seafood market, selling both live and dried fish. This market represents Busan and is famous throughout the country. Visitors can eat fresh raw fish right at the market.

- **Busan Air Cruise** - Was built to revive the reputation of Songdo Beach, the first public beach in Korea opened nearly 30 years ago. Travel over the ocean between Songnim Park on the east and Amnam Park on the west.
- **Oryukdo Skywalk** - Meaning a saddle, due to the shape of the point. The glass flooring was made by four layers of 12-millimeter glass panels coated with a bulletproof film for a total thickness of 55.49 millimeters, making the structure quite safe. Visitors will be thrilled with the view of the waves while looking down through the transparent floor.
- **Haedong Yonggungsa Temple** - Is situated on the coast of the north-eastern portion of Busan. This superb attraction offers visitors the rare finding of a temple along the shore line; most temples in Korea are located in the mountains. Other special sites at the temple are the 108 stairs and stone lanterns lining the rocky landscape. After going down the 108 steps, one will be delighted with the beauty of the temple.
- **Haeundae Beach Train** - A sightseeing train that serves as both a transportation option and a tourist train that runs round-trip from Mipo to Songjeong via Cheongsapo along the beautiful coastal scenery of East Busan.
- **Shinsegae Centum City** - Is registered in the Guinness World Records as the largest shopping complex in the world, offering a full range of entertainment options, from an ice rink to movie theater, golf range, and a spa.
