Day 02 BUSAN 🚌 YEOSU

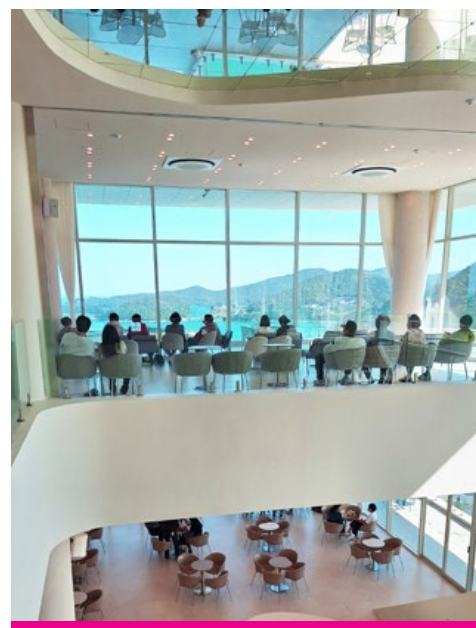
Lunch (Cockle Set Menu)

Discover the wonders of Korea's southern coast, starting with the **Suncheon Bay Wetland Reserve**, a world-class wetland teeming with diverse wildlife. Next, visit the **Suncheonman Bay National Garden**, Korea's first national garden, where you'll find a breathtaking array of flora and scenic landscapes (*Note: From March 8th to 17th, 2025, this will be replaced by a visit to the Gwangyang Maehwa Festival*). Finally, indulge in the culinary delights of **Nangman Pocha Street**, located beneath the Yeosu Geobukseon Bridge, where numerous food trucks offer a variety of delectable seafood dishes.

Day 03 YEOSU

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch (Pan Fried Spicy Chicken) / Dinner (Soya Sauce Marinated Crab Set)

Embark on a scenic adventure with a **Yeosu Cable Car** ride, Korea's first maritime cable car, offering breathtaking views of the ocean and the numerous islands of Yeosu. Experience the unique thrill of soaring above the landscape and capturing



stunning vistas. Explore the renowned **Yeosu Fish Market**, celebrated as one of Korea's finest small-city fish markets. Visit **MoiFin Café** (drink excluded), the largest in Yeosu, known for its awe-inspiring design and captivating views. Don't miss the chance to create your own **DIY Dolsan Gat Kimchi**, a unique local delicacy made from gat (leaf mustard) instead of cabbage. Finally, visit **Hyangiram Hermitage**, one of Korea's four Buddhist temples, nestled high in the mountains with panoramic views of the East Sea.



Day 04 YEOSU 🚆 GWANGJU

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch (Korean Duck Soup) / Dinner (BBQ Pork Buffet)

Explore the rich heritage of **Naganeupseong Folk Village**, the only remaining walled town from the Joseon era in Korea. Immerse yourself in the artistic charm of **Penguin Village**, adorned with vibrant murals and diverse artistic displays. Experience the bustling atmosphere of **Gwangju Yangdong Market**, a premier traditional market offering a wide variety of goods and delectable foods. Discover the innovative **G.MAP Gwangju Media Art Platform**, a UNESCO-recognized creative city initiative that bridges arts and life through captivating media art projects (*Note: If G.MAP is closed, the visit will be replaced by Jeonil Building 245*).

Day 05 GWANGJU 🚆 JINJU

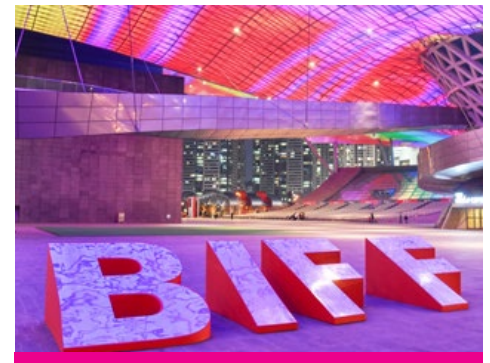
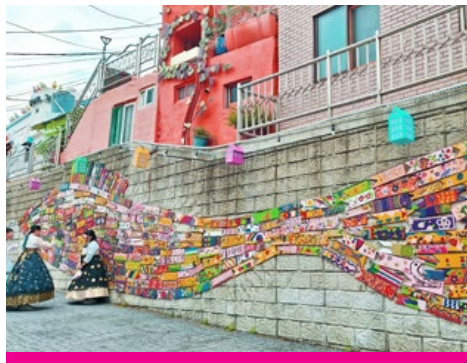
Hotel Breakfast / Lunch (Bamboo Set Menu + Grilled Short Rib Patties) / Dinner (Braised Pork Ribs In Potato Soup)

Immerse yourself in the serene beauty of **Juknokwon Bamboo Forest**, a sprawling 160,000 square meters bamboo haven in Damyang. Stroll down the picturesque **Metasequoia-lined Road**, one of Korea's most beautiful streets, with trees planted in the early 1970s. Experience the nostalgic charm of **Gokseong Seomjin Train Village** with a ride on an old steam engine train through stunning rural landscapes. (*Note: From October 28th to November 10th, 2024, this visit will be replaced by a trip to Naejangsan National Park.*) Delight in a Hanbok experience at **Gwanghallu (includes Hanbok Wearing)**, dressing in traditional Korean costume while exploring a historic pavilion from the Joseon Dynasty. Visit **Seodo Station**, lined with metasequoia trees, a favored autumn spot and famous filming location for "Mr. Sunshine," perfect for photography year-round. (*Bonus: From October 5th to 20th, 2024, enjoy the Jinju Namgang Yudeung Festival, and from March 9th to 17th, 2025, experience the Gurye Sansuyu Festival.*)

Day 06 JINJU 🚆 BUSAN

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch (Ginseng Chicken Soup) / Dinner (Unlimited Grilled Abalone and Seafood)

Begin your journey with a visit to the **Ginseng Showroom** to purchase premium ginseng products, followed by the **Cosmetic Duty-Free Outlet** for fantastic deals on skincare and cosmetic items. Explore **Gamcheon Cultural Village**, renowned for its colorful mosaic houses built on the slopes of Busan. Experience the lively atmosphere of **BIFF Square**, home to first-run movie theaters, delicious street food, and the handprints of famous Korean actors. Discover the bustling **Jagalchi Seafood Market**, Busan's most famous traditional seafood market.



Finally, immerse yourself in the vibrant **Bupyeong Kkangdong Market**, a covered market brimming with fresh produce, local delicacies, clothing, and street food vendors.
