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



- Nampodong Street The theatre district of Busan. Accommodation: Busan Crown Harbour Hotel or similar

Day 5

BUSAN – GYEONGJU Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Gamcheon Culture Village Also known as Korea's Santorini, this little village in Busan has its own artistic and historic charm that continues to attract visitors.
- Songdo Cable Car Spectacular coastal views of Songdo Beach from a scenic marine cable car ride. See the vast waters, cliffs and rock formations.
- Songdo Sky Walk Admire the spectacular and beautiful view of the ocean when you venture out on the Songdo Sky Walk.
- Bomun Lake is a 1.65 km² man-made lake and in spring the entire surrounding lake and park are lit up in a sea of pink and white cherry blossom. (Subject to weather conditions)

- **Cheomseongdae Observatory** is an interesting stone structure used to study the heavenly bodies in the olden Korean days.
- Woljeongyo Bridge was built during the Unified Silla period but burned down during the Joseon Dynasty. In 2018, Woljeonggyo was reborn as Korea's largest wooden bridge after its meticulous reconstruction based on historical research.
- Donggung Palace and Wolji Pond was a secondary palace used by the crown prince of the Silla Kingdom. It also served as a banquet site for important national events and important visitors.
