

TOKYO – MISHIMA - HAKONE - MT FUJI Beakfast, Dinner

· Mishima Skywalk

With a total length of 400m, the Skywalk is the longest pedestrian-only suspension bridge in Japan. From the bridge, you can overlook the beautiful scenery of Mt Fuji, Suruga Bay and Izu mountains.

Ōwakudani (Ropeway included) Owakudani's continuous steam and sulfur smoke are really incredible scenery of giant rock volcanoes. The view of the ropeway along the way is the most beautiful place in **Hakone** to appreciate Mt Fuji.

\*Note: Ropeway subject to weather conditions, if closed will replace by Hakone cruise.

- **Gotemba Premium Outlet** Gotemba Premium Outlet is the flagship center, and one of the largest centers in Japan. It is situated on an extensive site within view of World Cultural Heritage site, Mt. Fuji.
- · Accommodation: Tominoko Hotel or similar (Onsen Hot Spring)

MT FUJI – AZUMINO Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

• Mt Fuji 5th Station

At 2300 meters above sea level, the Fuji 5th Station offers a commanding view of the Fuji Five Lakes area below.

\*Note: Mt Fuji 5th Station mid Dec onwards subject to weather conditions

Oshino Hakkai

The eight springs found in **Oshino**, which is Yamanashi prefecture's important tourist attractions and is a part of the Mt Fuji World Heritage Site.


#### Sanno Machi


Take a stroll along the old streets of **Sanno-machi**, which retains the elegance well preserved traditional Japanese Houses
