Get to bag home best of Niigata food, sake, snacks as well as locally crafted home and kitchen ware at Ponshukan Marketplace. Nishikigoi no Sato, DIY your edition of rice cracker, Rice Cracker Kingdom, Fukushimagata Lagoon
