- Piazza Venezia See the towering monument dedicated to the first King of Italy

- Palazzo Vecchio The town hall of the city
- Piazza Della Signoria The center of political life since the 14th century. Today, it holds a copy of Michelangelo's David statue.
- Ponte Vecchio Also known as Old Bridge, is the only bridge across the river Arno in the city until the 13th Century.

- **Pisa** A city and a commune in Tuscany region
- Piazza del Miracoli A UNESCO World Heritage
- Baptistery of Saint John The largest baptistery in Italy from the 13th century
- Pisa Duomo See one of the wonders of Italy, it was the biggest cathedral in Europe for almost a century.
- The Bell Tower See the symbol of Pisa, famously known as The Leaning Tower of Pisa.

VENICE - MILAN

- Torre dell' Orologio A clock tower and its large astronomical Clock, standing over an arch that leads into one of the main shopping street of the
- Murano Glass Making Factory The art of glass blowing, a long tradition that passed through generations in Venice that mustn't be missed.
- Optional excursion: Gondola A traditional narrow and long Venetian rowing boat steered by a gondolier with the help of one long oar.







Day 6

MILAN - INTERLAKEN

- Milan The Fashion capital of Italy
- Castello Sforzesco Built in the 15th century, initially used as a military citadel, it was converted as a residence for the Dukes of Milan Next stop, see the home of famous Italian.
- La Scala Opera House See one of the most important Opera theatres in the world
- Galleria Vittorio Emanuele The living room of Milan as what the locals call, known for its Italian Fashion brands and cafes
- **Duomo of Milan** See the majestic cathedral with its grandiose Gothic façade and one of the largest in the world.

Day 7

INTERLAKEN - LUCERNE REGION

- Interlaken A picturesque resort Swiss town located in the mountainous Bernese Oberland and also the gateway to the Jungfraujoch. Half day free
- Lucerne Popular city known for its medieval architecture and its stunning location on the edge of Lake Lucerne
- Lion Monument A beautiful monument dedicated to the Swiss Guards who died during the French Revolution.
- Chapel Bridge A landmark of Lucerne and also one of the oldest covered wooden bridges in Europe.
- Old Town Picturesque Old Town Square peppered with historic fresco-adorned houses. You can do some shopping
- Bucherer A fame duty free store in Switzerland
- Optional excursion: You may wish to join a recommended excursion to the UNESO listed "Top of Europe" Jungfraujoch

- Mount Titlis Ascend to the submit by cable cars and the famous Titlis Rotair. Feel the chillness at the Titlis glacier cave, do a thrill walk over the Titlis Cliff Walk (weather permitting). Enjoy a snow mobile ride at Trubsee. Note: Snow mobile only available in December till end March, subject to opening dates and weather conditions. No replacement in the event if weather do not permit, subject to activity opening dates or in November
- Titisee-Neustadt A pretty little town locates in the Black Forest Region, Germany. You are able to do some shopping on brands Made in Germany.
- Lake Titisee An Alpine lake in the heart of the southern Black Forest
- Cuckoo Clock Demonstration Visit a cuckoo clock factory and understands the manufacturing process.

- **Louvre Museum** Drive through the compound of the Louvre and see its famous glass pyramid
- Fragonard Perfume Factory A visit to the factory of a popular Perfume brand in France
- Galeries Lafayette The biggest and well known departmental store in Paris for shopping. *Closed on Christmas, New Year's Eve and Labour Day


