DAY 1 SINGAPORE / TRANSIT CITY / BUDAPEST

DAY 2 ARRIVAL BUDAPEST (D)

Early morning arrival, freshen up at airport, continue with full day Budapest city tour. Known as the Pearl of Danube, Budapest is famous of its own style of architectures, a blend of Eastern and Western Europe. Sighting the gorgeous 700 rooms **Parliament House**, the **Baroque Royal Palace**, **medieval streets**, **Matthias Church's impressive mosaic tiled roof**, and **Fisherman's Bastion**, a medieval wall that was maintained by the Fisherman's Guild. Wander around here and you will think you've been transported into a fairy tale. **Check in the cruise and start your voyage of Danube in the evening.** This is also the moment where the Pearl of Danube shine at its most!

DAY 3 BRATISLAVA / PARNDORF OUTLET (B/D)

Bratislava, the Capital of Slovakia uniquely situated on the border of three countries. It is recently became known as a tourist destination. Enjoy a brief walking tour in the old town and leisure around. After lunch, heading to **Parndorf Outlet** to grab some good deals on international designer brands.

DAY 4 VIENNA (B/D)

For many centuries, Vienna was the glittering capital of a great Austria empire. It also has musical tradition which continued for centuries, and onward far into the twentieth century. **The Opera house** is one of the most representable building of this musical city. Visit **Saint Stephen cathedral** which is also the symbols of Vienna, standing tall in the center of the city with its ornately patterned, richly coloured roof. Stroll freely around the pedestrian streets, with boutiques shops, restaurants and cafes. If you have a sweet tooth, treat yourself an Original Sacher-Torte and enjoy the typical Viennese coffee-house atmosphere in Sacher Cafe.

DAY 5 MELK / DURNSTEIN (B/L/D)

Melk is an Austrian town on the River Danube, west of Vienna. It's known for the 11th-century Melk Abbey. Named as a UNESCO world cultural heritage site, it has a rich history dating back to 1089. The building as you see it today was constructed 18th century and contains some incredible architectural gems both inside and out, such as the elaborate frescoes and the marble hall. Take some time to stroll through the narrow streets of **Old Town Melk**, below the Benedictine Abbey. **The Town Hall Square** (Rathausplatz), **the Hauptstrasse**, and **the Main Square** (Hauptplatz) form the village center, together with Kremser Strasse and Wiener Strasse. In Sternstrasse is the old abbey tavern dating from 1736 with its stone statue of the Coronation of Our Lady, while parts of the old town wall and the Nibelungen Memorial Tablet (Nibelungen-Gedenktafel) can be visited in Kremser Strasse. Be sure to venture down to the banks of the Danube, home to the old shipping master's house and great views of the river. Finally, south of Linzer Strasse stands **the old post office** built in 1792 and now a local museum. **Dürnstein** is a small Austrian town of just over 900 people, best known for its grape growing and historic character. Today, it is regarded as the most romantic place in the Wachau Valley. Wander around at the colorful streets and enjoy some personal time.

DAY 6 LINZ / SALZBURG / HALLSTATT (B/D)

Upon our arrival at Linz, hop on private bus to **Salzburg**, the birth town of Mozart. Visit **Mirabell Garden**, with its gardens is a listed cultural heritage monument and part of the Historic Centre of the City of Salzburg UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here is also one of the famous scene you saw in Sound of Music movie. **Hallstatt**, another highlight of the day, so call the most beautiful lake town of Austria, a UNESCO heritage site as well. We will try our very best to ensure you have sufficient time to explore this wonderful place, both from top of the mountains and lake front.

Upon return to Linz, stroll freely at Linz till our embarkation to the cruise.

DAY 7 PASSAU / NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE (B/D)

End of cruise doesn't mark the end of our scenery enjoyment! Romantic fairy tale like **Neuschwanstein Castle** is awaiting! With its white limestone façade and deep blue turrets, is rumoured to be real-life inspiration for the castle in the Disney classic, Cinderella, and the Sleeping Beauty's castle in Disneyland. Not to miss as well the tiny unique **Germany Village Oberammergau**, famous of its Passion Play once every 10 years and it's woodcrafts.

DAY 8 MUNICH / TRANSIT CITY / SINGAPORE (B)

Transfer to airport and wish you a safe flight home! **Only for flight depart after 6.00pm**, special arrange to visit **Munich**, the capital of Bavaria state, the home of October fest, and the birthplace of BMW Automobile. Spend some free time at it's old town. If you will, grab yourself a pint of beer at **Hofbrauhaus**, and be a German!
