DAY 2: NADI

DAY 3: NADI

DAY 10: ROTORUA



Highlights: Agrodome Farm Show, Farm Tour, Te Puia, Te Whakarewarewa Thermal Valley, New Zealand Maori Arts and Crafts Institute, Kiwi Conservation Centre

After breakfast, enjoy **Agrodome Farm Show** and watch sheepdogs and 19 breeds of sheep perform. Then, join the **Farm Tour**, in which you get to ride a tractor to hand-feed and take photos with many friendly animals including Romney sheep, cattle, deer, llamas, ostriches, pigs and alpacas. Thereafter, visit **Te Puia** to view the natural wonderland of bubbling mud pools, erupting geysers and steaming hot springs at **Te Whakarewarewa Thermal Valley**.
