DAY 2: CHRISTCHURCH - GREYMOUTH



Highlights: International Antarctic Centre, 4D Extreme Theatre, Hagglund ride

DAY 3: GREYMOUTH - PUNAKAIKI - HOKITIKA - FOX GLACIER

Travel to **Hokitika** to view **glassblowing studio** and visit **greenstone centre**, where you will be able to shop for beautiful ornaments. Continue along the coast of Tasman Sea and marvel at the scenic views as you head towards to see the famous **Franz Josef Glacier**.

DAY 4: FOX GLACIER - WANAKA - QUEENSTOWN
