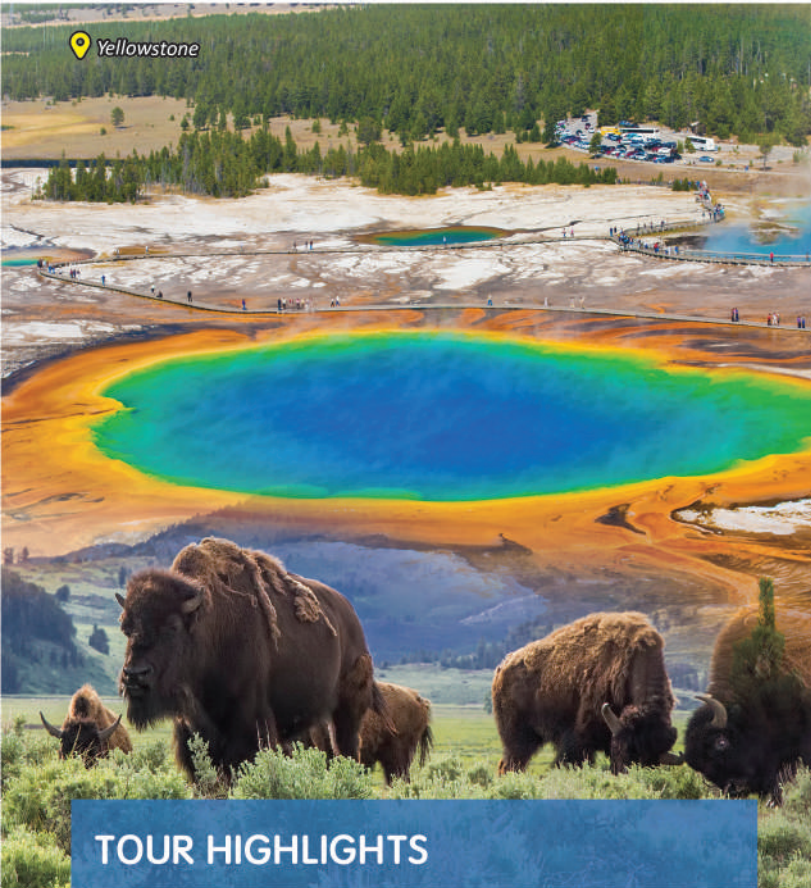

Visit to Zion National Park, where a drive through the park reveals the beautiful peaks of the mountains, the alpiners and the streams. Here you can feast your eyes on all kinds of sentinel rocks and spectacular sights created by Mother Nature. Bryce Canyon National Park awaits you, as our coach ascends to an elevation of 8000 feet. The park is endowed with some of the most spectacular rock formation in the world, known as “Hoodoo”. Many are formed as a result of water and wind erosion. Bryce Canyon is also known as the “Western Terra Cotta”!

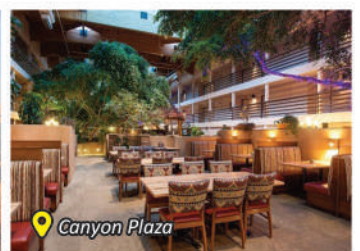

**Day 5 BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK – GRAND CANYON (SOUTH RIM)**

**Breakfast / Western Dinner**

Visit one of the seven scenic world wonders – The Grand Canyon National Park. Its average 8 million visitors a year. Stop at the rim of the lookout points at Grand Canyon and witness the world’s most spectacular illustration – 227 miles long, 18 miles wide and at its deepest point is more than 1 mile from river to rim. That makes this area a very popular location for photographers and tourists. Experience the overnight stay at the Grand Canyon area with a Buffet Dinner inclusive! 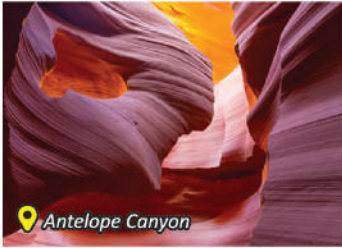


**Day 6 GRAND CANYON (SOUTH RIM) – ANTELOPE CANYON – HORSESHOE BEND – PAGE**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Morning, head direct to Antelope Canyon. It was formed by flash flood flows into the cracks of the Navajo sandstone and wind erosions. With the penetration of daylight through the narrow opening from the topo different kinds of light reflections and colors were created. That makes this are a popular location for photographers and tourists. Proceed to the area where the Colorado River made a 280 degree turn around the Horseshoe Bend. Overnight at Page.

**Day 7 PAGE – MONUMENT VALLEY – MOAB / GREEN RIVER**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Proceed to Monument Valley located on the border between Utah and Arizona. View the standing sandstone rock forms tht rise majestically from the desert floor. Up to 1000 feet tall, they create a truly magical desert balance “Stagecoach”.

**Day 9 DENVER – MT. RUSHMORE – RAPID CITY**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Travel northward to South Dakota. Visit Mt Rushmore – a monumental granite sculpture that represents the first 150 years of the history of USA with a 60 foot structure of the heads of former USA presidents: George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Thomas Jefferson. Overnight stay in Rapid City.

**Accommodation:** Holiday in Express or similar

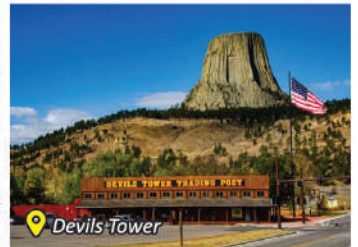


**Day 10 RAPIT CITY – WYOMING – DEVILS TOWER – RANCHESTER OR SHELIDAN**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Proceed to Devils Tower where Steven Spielberg movie “Close Encounter of the Third Kind” was filmed. Devils Tower is a butte, possibly laccolithic, composed of igneous rock in the Bear Lodge Ranger District of the Black Hills. It rises 1,267 feet above the Belle Fourche River, standing 867 feet from summit to base.

**Day 8 MOAB – ARCHES NATIONAL PARK – DENVER**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Visit the magnificent Arch National Park, a symphony of colors and shapes created by the forces of nature. Arches National Park contains the world’s largest concentration of natural stone arches. This National Park is a red arid desert, punctuated with oddly eroded sandstone from such as finds. Pinnacles, spires, balance rocks and arches. This 73000 acres region has over 2000 of these ‘miracles of nature’. Proceed to Denver for your overnight stay.

**Day 11 RANCHESTER – YELLOWSTONE – CANYON LODGE**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Yellowstone National Park is a nearly 3,500-sq.-mile wilderness recreation area atop a volcanic hot spot. The park spreads into parts of Montana and Idaho too. Yellowstone features dramatic canyons, alpine rivers, lush forests, hot springs and gushing geysers, including its most famous, Old Faithful. It’s also home to hundreds of animal species, including bears, wolves, bison, elk and antelope.

**Day 12 YELLOWSTONE – GRAND TETON – JACKSON HOLE – POCATELLO**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Today, passes by Grand Teton range. Rising above a scene rich with extraordinary wildlife, pristine lakes, and alpine terrain, the Teton Range stands as a monument to the people who fought to protect it. These are mountains of the imagination. Mountains that led to the creation of Grand Teton National Park. Proceed to Jackson Hole's for lunch. You will have some free time to explore this town. The Town Square features arches made of shed antlers from the National Elk Refuge. After proceed to Pocatello. In early days, pioneers, settlers and gold miners passed through Pocatello, a "Gate City" to Yellowstone National Park, on their way west. Pocatello is still a popular destination, a lively valley city surrounded by mountains, steeped in history and full of outdoor fun, from Nordic skiing and ice fishing in winter to hiking and biking in the summer.

**Day 13 POCATELLO – TWIN FALLS – WINNEMUCCA**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Shoshone Falls — "the Niagara of the West" is a must-see. These falls put on a show in spring and early summer, when water flows are at their peak after winter snowmelt. During high water years, the falls attract thousands of out-of-town spectators who come to witness nature's awesome power. The falls travel a whopping 200 feet to the water below, framed by the rocky canyon walls. These falls are a favorite of photographers and can be snapped from above on the Snake River Canyon Rim Trail or below at Centennial Park. Proceed to Winnemucca for your overnight stay.

**Day 14 WINNEMUCCA – LAKE TAHOE – SACRAMENTO – SAN FRANCISCO**

**Breakfast / Dinner**

Lake Tahoe is a large freshwater lake in the Sierra Nevada Mountains, straddling the border of California and Nevada. It's known for its beaches and ski resorts. Sacramento, capital of the U.S. state of California, lies at the confluence of the Sacramento River and American River. The district of Old Sacramento harkens back to the city's Gold Rush era, with wooden sidewalks and wagon rides. Proceed for your overnight stay in City by the Bay – San Francisco.
