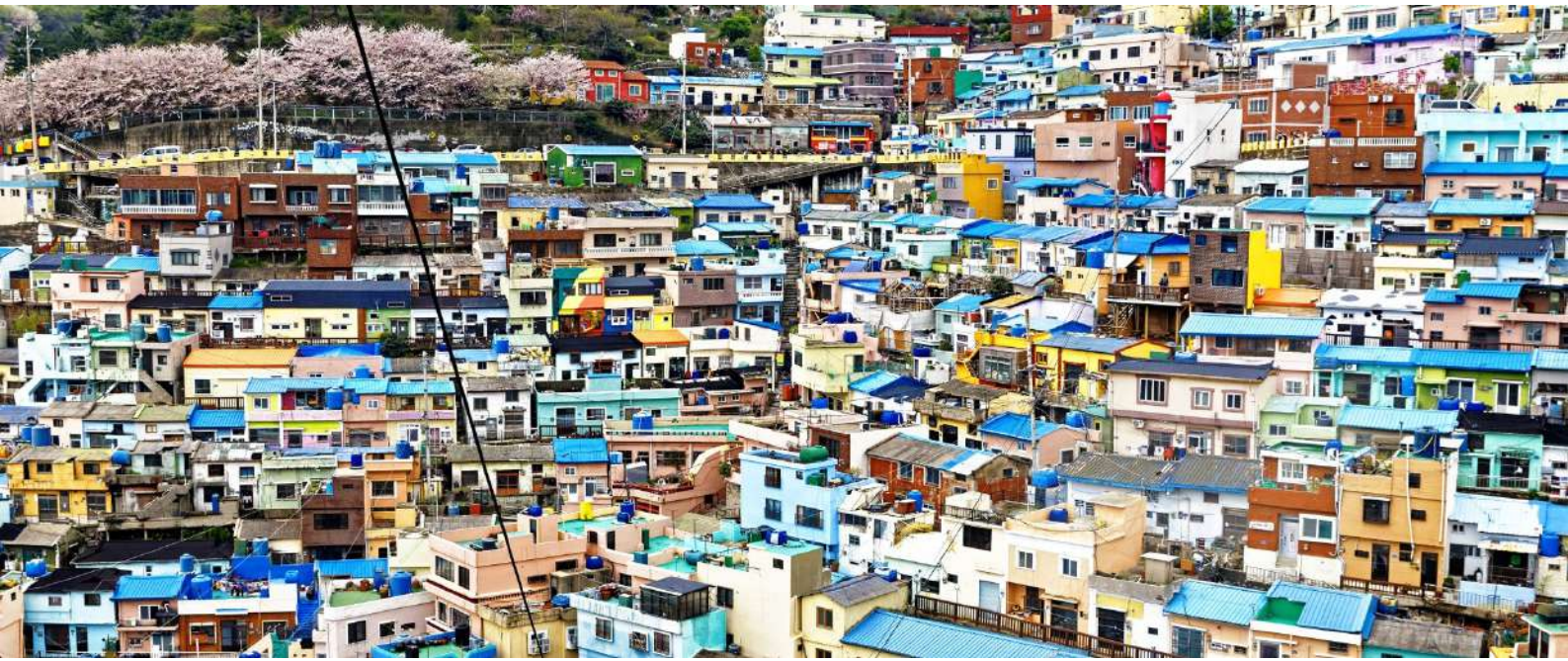
Jeju Island is famous for its abundance of fresh fruits, enjoy a session of fruits picking directly from the orchard during the respective fruit seasons.
