### Day 01 SINGAPORE > INCHEON

Assemble at Changi International Airport for your flight to Incheon, Korea.

## Day 02 INCHEON A SEOUL A MOKPO

Lunch/Dinner

Upon arrival in Incheon, we will commence our tour by visiting Gyeongbokgung Palace, the first royal palace constructed during the Joseon Dynasty. Renowned for its timeless beauty, this palace is a captivating destination throughout all seasons. Subsequently, we'll transfer to Mokpo via the KTX bullet train. Along the way, we'll pause for a photo stop at Mokpo Modern History Hall 1, formerly known as the Mokpo Japanese Consulate. This historic edifice, the oldest in Mokpo, bears witness to Korea's modern and contemporary narrative. Notably, it gained further acclaim as a filming site for the popular drama, Hotel Del Luna.

## Day 03 MOKPO ☐ SINAN ☐ MOKPO

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Enjoy a scenic drive to Sinan County. Upon arrival, you will be mesmerized by the uniqueness of the **Sinan** "**Purple Islands**". Everything is purple here, from fields of purple flowers, purple roads, purple houses, purple bridges, and even purple-themed foods! Here we will visit the iconic Banwol Island, Moon Bridge and Purple Bridge.

Next, explore **Dongbu Traditional Market**, which is the largest traditional market in Mokpo City. End your day by enjoying the sunset on the **Mokpo Marine Cable Car** where you can get a balanced view of mountains, sea, and city.

## Day 04 MOKPO GOKSEONG BOSEONG GWANGJU

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

After breakfast, visit **Seomjingang Gokseong Train Village**, where you can enjoy listening to the blunt sound of a locomotive. There is also a garden with 1,004 different types of roses from all over the world, during the Spring to Summer seasons. Next, proceed to **Boseong Green Tea Fields**, a popular instagrammable attraction thanks to the vast rows of tea trees that line the hillside like a deep green carpet.

## Day 05 GWANGJU A DAMYANG – JEONJU SEOUL

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Begin your day with a serene stroll through **Juknokwon**, a sprawling 16,000-square meter bamboo forest adorned with artificial waterfalls, pavilions, and traditional Korean architecture. Next, venture to **Damyang Metasequoia-lined Road**, a breathtaking boulevard renowned for its ethereal beauty reminiscent of a fairy tale landscape. During autumn, when the trees transform into a radiant golden yellow, the road reaches its



pinnacle of splendour. Afterwards, enjoy a leisurely coach ride to Jeonju, reveling in the picturesque scenery along the way. Upon arrival, delve into the charm of **Jeonju Hanok Village**, home to over 800 traditional courtyard houses known as hanok, offering a captivating glimpse into Korean heritage and architecture.

## Day 06 SEOUL A YONGIN SEOUL

### Hotel Breakfast / Dinner

Kick off your morning with an exhilarating adventure at **Everland Theme Park**, the largest of its kind in Korea. Spanning five themed areas including Global Fair, American Adventure, Magic Land, Zootopia, and European Adventure, Everland promises an array of attractions to delight visitors of all ages. The park is also known for its festive decorations tailored to themed festivals throughout the year. Following your park escapade, include in a delightful **seasonal fruit-picking experience** at a local farm, savouring the freshest produce straight from the source. Conclude your day by returning to Seoul.

### Day 07 SEOUL

Begin your morning with a visit to the Ginseng Monopoly Showroom, where you can explore the wonders of this revered herb. Then, indulge in a skincare shopping spree at an Odbo cosmetic store, stocking up on premium Korean skincare products. Next, immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere of **Gwangjang Market**, Korea's pioneering marketplace renowned for its lively energy, and made famous by the popular Korean show "Running Man". Afterward, unleash your inner shopaholic at **Myeongdong Shopping Street**, a bustling



hub brimming with a diverse array of shops offering fashion items, accessories, and more.
