Day 3: Wollongong - Jevis Bay - Canberra (341km/4h40min)

taste award-winning wines and fresh food among gorgeous rural surrounds, you will definitely find something that suits your taste bud.

Day 4: Canberra - Albury (337km/3h40min)

There are also arrays of attractions well suited for families, places like the interactive Questacon The National Science and Technology Centre where you may find yourself on a 360 degree swing or watching a lightning bolt. Cockington Green Gardens' miniature world and gardens will definitively delight you. Continue your journey to Albury, there are plenty of things to see and do in and around the city. Albury is renowned for its magnificent heritage buildings. Find a fascinating collection of stories and objects at the award-winning Library Museum or drop into one of the country's best regional art galleries. The wider Albury area has good shopping as well as many fine restaurants. Kids will love Oddies Creek Playspace and the magic of the Children's Garden at the city's Botanic Gardens.

Day 5: Albury - Bendigo (312km/3h40min)

Today, continue your Journey to Bendigo. Central Deboarh Gold Mine discovered gold during the 1850s made it one of the most significant Victorian era boomtowns in Australia, 25 million ounces of gold (777 tonnes) have been extracted from Bendigo, making it the highest producing goldfield in Australia in the 19th century and making it one of the richest city in Australia. In the vibrant contemporary regional centre, boasting beautiful streets created from one of the world's greatest gold rushes. Every visit will reveal new surprises and experiences. With the gusto of a gold-seeking miner, the people who live here are creating fascinating products, services and stories that add to the richness of the region's boom time past. It is an

ever-changing feast to be explored. Nearby Heathcote has not missed the beat with artisans of food, wine and art flocking to be part of the action.

Not to be missed is the Phillip Island Chocolate Factory, a tempting treat that everyone finds hard to resist! For the young at heart, a trip to A Maze'N Things will stimulate their minds through interactive optical illusions, puzzles and mazes.
