SYDNEY - PORT STEPHEN

SYDNEY - BLUE MOUNTAIN - SYDNEY

This morning, visit **Sydney Zoo** and get up close with native Australian animals such as the Tasmanian Devils and many more. Proceed to **Blue Mountain National Park**. A national park listed under the UNESCO in 2000. Dominate the area by the **Three Sisters Rocks**, an unusual rock formation within the national park north of Jamison Valley. Take the **Scenic Cableway** up at 545 meters and descend slowly into the Valley of Jamison. Continue with the **Scenic Railway**, the steepest railway in the world. Explore the national park at your own pace and you may get a chance to come across wild species of native Australian animals.
