Day 1 Singapore – Copenhagen

Meals on Board

Assemble at Changi Airport for your long-haul flight to Copenhagen with Travel 21.

Day 2 Copenhagen – Faroe Island

Western Dinner

Upon arrival Copenhagen take flight to Faroe Island– Tucked between Iceland and Norway in the North Atlantic Ocean.

Transfer to **Tórshavn**– is the capital and largest city of the Faroe Islands, leisure and shopping at Tórshavn old town. Photo stop at **Tinganes**, the historic location of the Faroese landsstýri (government).

Day 3 Tórshavn – Tjørnuvík – Gjógv – Tórshavn

Breakfast/Light lunch/Dinner on Board

This morning transfer to **Tjørnuvík**, the northernmost village on Streymoy Island. Photo stop of **Risin og Kellingin** at the beach in Tjørnuvík, enjoy the scenic view of Sea stacks. Later drive to Fossa, is one of the highest waterfalls in the Faroe Islands, and one of the biggest attractions in northern Streymoy. Photo stop at **Eiði village**, another good view of Risin og Kellingin.

Head to **Gjógv**– the small picturesque settlement Gjógv (Gorge) on the north of the island Eysturoy.

Photo stop at **Gjógv Natural Harbor**, follow the trail to Crown Princess Mary's Bench

After lunch transfer back for Tórshavn, outside visit the only preserved pilot whaling station – **Við Áir**.

Photo stop at **Funningur Scenic Point, the viewpoint at Kaldbaksbotnur**

Day 4 Mykines Island

Breakfast/Asian Lunch/Western Dinner

Today transfer to Vágar Island visit **Klovningur** with local guide, it's a small sea stack near the famous Trøllkonufingur. Photo stop at **Witches Finger Trail**, hike and photo tour at Mykines Islands– the Island is the home of thousands of puffins and offers spectacular views and awe-inspiring nature.

After transfer to **Gásadalsgarður**, photo stop at **Bjør Panoramic Viewpoint**: Drangarnir, Tindhólmur and Gáshólmur, view **Múlafossur Waterfall**– The picture-perfect Múlafossur is easily the most famous attraction in the Faroe Islands.

Day 5 Tórshavn – Klaksvík – Kalsoy Island – Tórshavn

Breakfast/Asian Lunch/ Asian Dinner

Today visit **Klaksvík** with our local guide, Klaksvík is the second largest city in the Faroe Islands. Photo stop at **Mikladalur**, is a village on Kalsoy Island located in the northern part of the unbelievable Faroe Islands, hike to Tombstone of James Bond. Photo stop at the **Kallur Lighthouse**, it's was built in 1927 and is a popular attraction in the Faroe Islands, here you will see a breathtaking view. Transfer back to Tórshavn.

Day 6 Tórshavn – Reykjavik

Breakfast /Chinese Lunch/Western Dinner

This morning take flight to Reykjavik–the Capital and largest city in Iceland.

Reykjavik city tour including outside visit Perlan, photo stop at **Hallgrímskirkja Cathedral**, **Hofdi Summit House** and **Opera House**.

Day 7 Reykjavik– Kulusuk

Breakfast/ Western Lunch/Western Dinner

After breakfast transfer to airport take flight to Kulusuk, is an island in the Sermersooq municipality on the Southeastern shore of Greenland. Walk to **Kulusuk village**, a traditional hunting village of Greenland, with its 200 inhabitants it is scenically located.

Day 8 Kulusuk

Breakfast/ Western Lunch / Western Dinner

Experience **a boat tour to Apusiaajik Glacier**– sailing past fascinating variety of floes and icebergs a cross the local fjord, the tour takes you close to our local glacier Apusiaajik ('little' glacier) with our open 10–person open boat.(subject to weather condition)

Please note: If the group size exceeds the maximum capacity of 10 paxs for both Boat Tour and Mountain Drive tour, the group will split into two. Do the tour simultaneously and swap afterwards.

Mountain Drive– Travelling by car, the tour takes us to a previous us military radar station. From here we have a view towards the majestic coastal mountains to the ocean seeing ice floes and icebergs in the distance. A wonderful chance to have a panoramic view of our stunning landscape. (Subject to weather condition)

Day 9 Kulusuk – Tasiilaq

Breakfast / Western Lunch / Western Dinner

Enjoy a short 10 minute **helicopter ride to Tasiilaq**. (Subject to weather permitting)

Whale Watching and Icebergs Boat Tour – Sailing amongst the pack ice, heading towards the icebergs. (Subject to weather condition)

Walking tour to the **Flower Valley** – This ramble takes visitors out of Ammassalik "town" into a luxuriant valley where one sees the arctic summer flora and landscape.

Day 10 Tasiilaq –Kulusuk – Reykjavik

Breakfast/Chinese Dinner

After breakfast back to Kulusuk by Helicopter.

Then take flight to Reykjavik, upon arrival transfer to hotel for the rest.



Day 11 Reykjavik – Golden Circle – Vik

Breakfast / Western Lunch / Western Dinner

Today start Golden Circle tour to **Thingvellir National Park**– is it the only UNESCO World Heritage Site on the Icelandic mainland, **Gullfoss**– is one of Iceland’s most iconic and beloved waterfalls, found in the Hvítá river canyon in Southwest Iceland. The **Geysir** is a famous hot spring in the geothermal area of Haukadalur Valley, found in south-west Iceland.



Day 12 Vik– Jokulsarlon – Vik

Breakfast / Western Lunch / Western Dinner

Head to **Jokulsarlon** – is Iceland’s most famous glacier lagoon, photo stop at **Skaftafell National Park**– was established in 1967, Iceland’s second largest national park.

Enjoy **Amphibious Tour** in Glacier Lake, during the excursion you sail among the huge icebergs in the picturesque scenery of Jökulsárlón.



Day 13 Vik – Blue Lagoon – Reykjavik

Breakfast / Western Lunch / Western Dinner

Today continue our journey to **Black Sand Beach**– has coined the name Diamond Beach, as the ice chunks lying on it resemble diamonds glistening in the sun. Photo stop at most beautiful and dramatic waterfalls – **Skogafoss** and **Seljalandsfoss**.

Inside visit of **Blue Lagoon (towel included)** – Immerse yourself in warmth at our oceanside geothermal lagoon, as the dramatic North Atlantic Ocean stretches out before you.



Day 14 Reykjavik–Copenhagen

Breakfast / Chinese Dinner

This morning transfer to airport take flight to Copenhagen. Free at leisure at Copenhagen.



Day 15 Copenhagen – Singapore

Breakfast / Meals on Board

Free at leisure until transfer to Copenhagen airport take flight back to Singapore.

Day 16 Singapore
