SINGAPORE - DA NANG
Dinner

Day 2

HUE - DA NANG - HOIAN

- **Linh Ung Pagoda** - Located in Son Tra Peninsula, the pagoda is home to the 67m tall Goddess of Mercy.
- **Marble Mountain** - The mountain boasts of sacred pagodas, caves, not forgetting the view points for panoramic view of the nearby country side.
- **Hoi An Ancient Town** - The Unesco World Culture Heritage ancient town remains notably well-preserved today. Cross the Japanese Bridge, visit the Trieu Chau Assembly House and the 200-year-old Tan Ky House.

- **My Son Sanctuary** - The Unesco site tells of the historical, cultural, architectural, and artistic values developed between the 4th to 13th century.
