You may take an optional 308-metre-long chairlift ride at your own expense. Next, proceed to Tasmanian Gourmet Sauce Company where you may savour some award-winning jams and chutneys. Head to 41° South Tasmania, where you will embark on a guided tour of the freshwater salmon ponds and get to savour smoked salmon. Visit Ashgrove Cheese Dairy Door to view the production of this well-loved dairy product and savour different types of cheese including the delectable chilli cheese. Lastly, visit The House of Anvers for a guided tour of the museum of chocolate.
