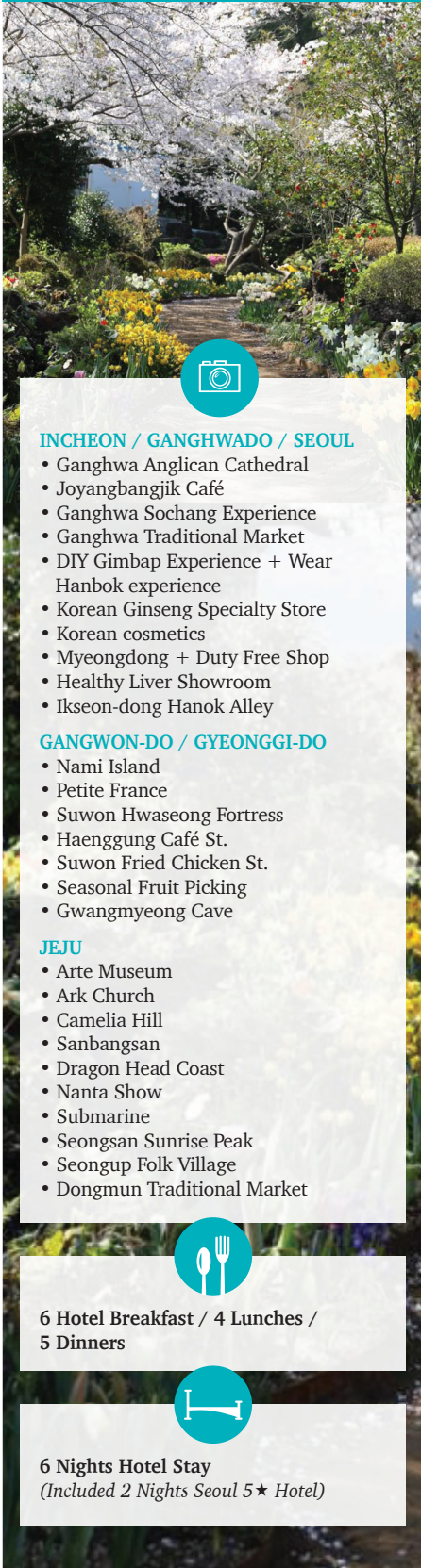

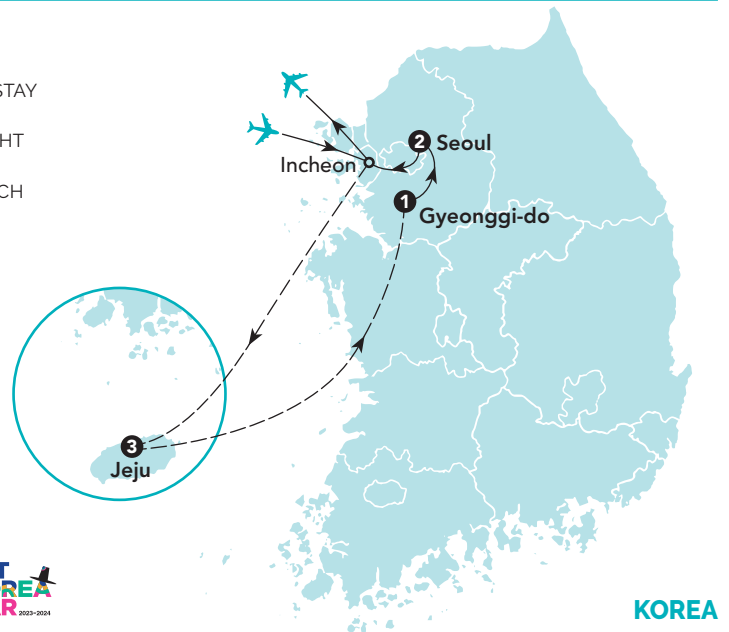

KOREA

DAY 1 SINGAPORE → INCHEON

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and begin your holiday with a pleasant flight to Seoul.

DAY 2 INCHEON - GIMPO → JEJU

- Meal on Board / Lunch: Famous Ganghwa Ginseng Chicken Soup / Dinner: Haemul Tang -

Upon arrival meet and greet with our local representative. Proceed to **Ganghwa Anglican Cathedral**, also known as Ganghwa-eup, Ganghwa county, is a cathedral of the Anglican Church's Diocese of Seoul that opened on November 15, 1900. It is the first Hanok-style cathedral in Korea as well as the first one in Ganghwado island. Next, visit **Joyangbangjik Café** the old textile factory that transformed into a café and feel the charm of the vintage style. Enjoy a drink and have fun posing for photos there! Painting experience with sochang cotton at the **Ganghwa Sochang Experience Center**. Next, you can enjoy the **Ganghwa Traditional Market**. Thereafter, transfer to Gimpo domestic airport.

Seasonal Inclusion: During cherry blossom season, Ganghwa Goryeo Gungji views cherry blossoms.

DAY 3 JEJU

- Hotel Breakfast / Lunch: Jeju's famous black pork barbecue -

Today, visit the contemporary **Arte Museum**, Korea's largest immersive media art exhibition, organised by a world-class digital design company, d'strict, which is also well-known for the public media art "WAVE" presented at Coex. Next, we visit **Ark Church** (Japanese and Korean architect Jun Itami won the 2010 Korean Architectural Association Award). The building is a work of art. The beautifully designed church seems to float on the water. Surrounded by lawns,

the scenery is beautiful. Continue to visit Jeju Island's **Camelia Hill** Korean Net Beauties Instagram check-in hotspots. It is the largest camellia garden in the world, with about 6,000 varieties of camellias. There will be different kind of flowers blossoming depending on seasons. Azaleas, tulips, and hydrangeas can be seen during mid-April through October. Chrysanthemums, camellias, and cherry blossom will bloom throughout the period from November to March. (peak camellia viewing period from December-January). **Sanbangsan**, located southwest of Jeju Island, is a bell-shaped volcano with a beautiful view. The sea cave called Sanbang Cave is a unique landscape overlooking the mountains and sea, and it is also the tenth place on Jeju Island. One of the must-see attractions. Next, visit to **Dragon Head Coast**. The Sanbang Mountains are eroded when they extend to the coast, and they look like a dragon head plunging into the sea, so it is called the Dragon Head Sea shore. There are sandstone layers that have been accumulated over tens of millions of years. A cave that is deeply sunken like a room. The eroded rock formations are piled up with beautiful curves in the wide rock face, and the scenery is spectacular. Continue to **Dongmun Traditional Market**. This is the largest and longest standing market in Jeju. A mix of public markets, night markets, traditional markets and fish markets selling a wide variety of food and goods, it is a place frequented by tourists.

Note: In the event that, due to weather conditions, Dragon Head Coast is replaced by Jusangjeolli Cliff, known as "God's sculpture made by wave and wind" at Daepo Coast.

Seasonal Inclusion (23 Mar - 5 Apr): Jeju University's night cherry blossom viewing.

DAY 4 JEJU

- Hotel Breakfast / Lunch: *Pork Teppanyaki*
/ Dinner: *Abalone Hot Stone bibimbap* -

After breakfast, we will hop into a **Submarine** (subject to prevailing weather conditions) and submerge into the ocean to marvel at the interesting marine life, from the glass window. Continue to **Seongsan Sunrise Peak** (a **UNESCO World Natural Heritage site**), which is 180m above sea level and erupted underwater in the ocean about 5,000 years ago. Since ancient times, watching the sunrise at the top of Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak has always been one of the top ten scenic spots in Jeju. previously listed as a local monument, was designated as a natural monument on July 19, 2000, and was officially registered as a World Natural Heritage site in 2007.

*Seasonal Inclusion Seopjikoji:
Canola flower viewing (canola from the
end of March to April 20)*

When it comes to the flowers that represent spring in Jeju Island, rapeseed flowers are indispensable. Especially in southern Jeju, where the climate is warmer, yellow flowers bloom in late winter and continue throughout the spring. Next, we visit **Seongeup Folk Village**. Seongeup Folk Village is located at the foot of Halla Mountain. It is a folk village that completely preserves Korean traditions. It retains the original appearance of the ancient village. When you take a walk here, you will feel as if you are stepping back in time. In addition, you can also come into contact with the unique indigenous culture of Korea, which is very popular with foreigners. Enjoy **NANTA**, which has achieved outstanding global acceptance. It is a non-verbal stage performance that dramatises culinary art and customary Korean percussion.

Note: In the event of inclement weather, the submarine will be replaced by a foot bath, a Teddy Bear Museum, and hands-on Teddy Bear Making.

DAY 5 JEJU → GIMPO - GYEONGGI-DO SUWON

- Hotel Breakfast / Dinner: *Korean BBQ Buffet* -

When we return to Seoul, we will see the miracle of an abandoned mine that was abandoned for 40 years and reopened as the **Gwangmyeong Cave theme park**. Next, visit Suwon **Hwaseong Fortress** (World Cultural Heritage). The most recent Korean drama filming location. Next, proceed to **Haenggung-dong Mural Village** and Suwon **Haenggung Café Street**, a hidden gem filled with pretty restaurants and cafes that serve the finest and most aesthetic food in the city. Next, proceed to **Suwon Fried Chicken Street**, well-known Korean Fried Chicken, and Chi-mac (*Chicken and Beer*) are all popular options. Continue to **Experience Seasonal Fruit Picking** (*strawberry picking*

at the end of April, followed by tomato picking from the end of April to the end of September).

DAY 6 GYEONGGI-DO - GANGWONDO

- Hotel Breakfast / Lunch: *Chuncheon Teppanyaki Chicken* / Dinner: *Troop Pot* -
Begin the day to visit **Nami Island**, then proceed to visit **Petite France Village** (the "You from the Stars" filming site). From Cheongpyeong Dam to Nami Island, walk along the lake and you can see the exotic buildings of white huts gathered together. Just looking at the buildings, it looks like a small village concentrated on the coast of the sea, and when viewed with the beautiful scenery around Huming Mountain, it looks like an idyllic village at the foot of the Alps, so it is called the French Culture Village Petite France.

DAY 7 SEOUL

- Hotel Breakfast / Lunch: *Michelin restaurant satisfy Pork Knuckle Set* -
After breakfast, proceed to **Korean Ginseng Specialty Store**. You may wish to purchase the world-famous **Taiji ginseng** and **ginseng essence**, which have great effects on regulating the body and nourishing qi. Next, enjoy shopping at the **Korean cosmetics store** where Korea-manufactured beauty products are available at affordable prices. Following that, you will enjoy the **DIY gimhap** and **Hanbok Experience**. Do you know the Netflix K-drama "Extraordinary Attorney Woo"? This time you can make Gimhap like Woo! A unique Korean travel experience (in traditional costumes) is also available. Put on the ancient traditional Hanbok and happily capture the beautiful shadow in the antique traditional Hanok-style scene. We will continue our shopping in **Myeongdong shopping street + Shinsaegae Duty Free Shop**. Myeongdong has always been the number one tourist attraction in Seoul and a must-see for foreign tourists. The reason is that Myeongdong has the highest land price in Korea, the floating population can reach more than one million a day, and it is the most famous shopping and sightseeing spot in Korea.

DAY 8 SEOUL - INCHEON → SINGAPORE

- Hotel Breakfast -

After breakfast, proceed to the **Healthy Liver Showroom**. The main ingredient

of Huginbao, *Hovenia dulcis* fruit stalk extract powder HD-1, Premium, was selected from the *Hovenia dulcis* tree by the research of Dr. Luo Tianxiu for 10 years, using high and low molecular separation methods, which is very effective for the liver functional effect. Next, proceed to **Ikseon-dong Hanok Alley**, which was formed around the 1920s and has a unique architectural style that combines tradition and modernity. The narrow and winding alleys of Ikseon-dong are quite unique, and each shop and cafe has a variety of different special decorations, so the entire Ikseon-dong is like a photo area. In addition, it is recommended to write down the cafe's signboard or unique murals to avoid getting lost in Hanok Alley. Stroll along Ikseon-dong Hanok Alley, Old Street. You will be transferred to the airport for your flight back to Singapore. We hope that you had a memorable vacation with ASA Holidays.
